To whom it may concern,

This letter is an attempt to show how the presence of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh is good for the city of Rajneeshpuram, the state of Oregon and the U.S.A. As a lover of Bhagwan and a recognized artist in this country, I have found that being near Bhagwan influences my work, my worship and my well-being as has no other situation. Working, which feels like worship in Rajneeshpuram, has great positivity and joy to it. My creativity is sparked to a degree unknown to me prior to being in his presence. At this time, in this growing city there is much more need

for construction workers than for artists and so I've quite happily left my paints and now use other tools. But still there is a creativity in all and any work in which I participate. The supportive and non-competitive nature of the work situations here helps to keep my heart happy and my mind creative rather than worried and stressful.

Although his public discourses have not been continued since his arrival here, so many of his words are recorded in books and tapes that I can turn quite easily to any subject from A to Z. Now it seems that my interest in philosophy and psychology is fading and my curiosity is awakening to thoughts of a more religious nature and although Bhagwan has spoken extensively on this subject, it now seems that the knowledge I'm after is that which must be experienced.

So that now it's more than his words,  
it's his mere presence which inspires  
me and is inspiring many people who  
visit here or talk to those who have.

To this point I bring your  
attention. Somehow, when I am  
here with this spiritually enlightened  
master whom at least a quarter million  
people feel is on the same level as  
a Jesus of Nazareth, a Gautam the  
Buddha or a Krisna, I experience  
religion. It is something which words  
can only point toward and I'm well  
aware of this as I write. The personal  
phenomenon as it happens in  
various hues and subtleties consistently  
results in a lightness of heart and a  
lucidity, a clearing of my vision  
and my thoughts. This feeling has  
been part of my life as a young child  
when simply gazing at a tree or a  
cloud would bring such a joy. When  
a look or a word from my brother or

my mom or dad would cause such a pleasure that in retrospect it seems I had quite a few ecstatic moments.

Nothing had produced feelings similar to the ecstatic happiness of those early days until I felt the simple joy I now experience daily in this most remarkable city of Rajneeshpuram. Another point of focus is that the most remarkable aspect of our city is that we are blessed by the actual physical presence of Bhagwan Shri Rajneesh who is still here in his body only for the benefit and spiritual health of mankind. Throughout the world it seems that people who have heard of our experimental city are becoming hopeful about the possibility of a society in which there is no crime, violence, racism, poverty, ill-health or other perversions and where people

work and play together in an atmosphere of support and understanding. Come, see for yourself, you and any visitor will be welcome to look where you will listen to whom you choose and experience your own perception of being in close proximity to a living master. Would you have stayed at your desk and looked so critically if you were near Galilee in 33 A.C. ???
