To whom it may concern:

My association with Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh and his work began about 10 years ago when I was employed in the architectural profession. I had previously trained at Willesden College of Technology, London, and qualified as an Associate Member of the Institute of British Designers.

The projects I was mainly involved with were to do with housing, some of which won Greater London Council awards. The course of my work brought up a number of questions about man living in harmony with his environment, and the teachings of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh have answered a lot of those questions. Here at Rajneeshpuram is the example coming into being of a commune where people live together in tune with their environment and with one another.

My personal inquiry led me towards the meditations devised by Bhagwan and to the therapy techniques evolved and developed at the ashram in Poona.
