In 1981, 64,000 acres of land was purchased in Oregon - a virtual wasteland of overgrazed and dry land. Since the summer of 1981, when the land was purchased, amazing and beautiful things have happened.

A complete city is in the process of being created; a huge reservoir of water now exists, the land is being farmed and crops are used to feed the citizens of the city and surplus crops are being prepared to sell to surrounding communities; livestock provide eggs, milk and cheese, the land is turning green. In addition several festivals have happened and have brought people from all over the world to visit this land - two of these festivals alone brought 20,000 people.

The details I have written do not begin to describe what is really taking place. And the most immense fact is that all this is inspired directly by the presence of one most extraordinary and rare human being - Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh.

The presence of Bhagwan has transformed and is continuing to transform my life in a similar manner to how his inspiration is transforming a barren land into an oasis for hundreds of people who live in Rajneeshpuram and for the thousands who come to visit.

In July of this year, we celebrated the second annual celebration. It was a living celebration held in gratitude to this beautiful man - Bhagwan and to his messages of love. 15,000 people arrived and each day in the early morning we sat in simple silence, love and meditation with Bhagwan.

These people were housed and fed with great joy and ease as a direct inspiration from the presence

of Bhagwan.

It is astounding to realize that so many people come and will continue to come just simply to be in presence of Bhagwan, to continue sharing His message amongst each other, with the world and with the environment.

The celebration and appreciation of Him continues in my heart and the hearts of His sanyasins and manifests in creating Rajneeshpuram and in deeply caring for and harmonizing with the environment and in sharing this learning with the surrounding communities in America.
